

Bourbon Street Parade (comp. Paul Barbarin, 1955)

Paul Barbarin was a drummer who played in many New Orleans bands in the 1920s, including King Oliver's . Recording by the Wynton Marsalis Trio. (trumpet /bass/drums)

*Here we assume the lead instrument is the trumpet unless otherwise specified.
Overall, the performance has an intro, goes through the form of the song 8 times and there is an Outro.*
